

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

The Undersigned voluntarily waive(s) and release(s) any and all rights and claims for damages that the Undersigned and/or Student may have against School, its employees, trustees, officers, agents, and escorts or chaperones (serving without compensation), and any other party providing supervision, counseling, or instruction in connection with this field trip, arising out of or related to any loss, damage or injury, including death, which may be sustained by Student or by the Undersigned during or as a result of Student's participation in the field trip.

It is understood and agreed that the School, its employees, trustees and officers, are not hereby released from any claims or damages for intentional wrongdoing on their part, or for any negligence on their part for which the School has general liability insurance coverage.

The Undersigned further indemnify(ies) and hold(s) harmless School, its employees, trustees, officers, and escorts or chaperones (serving without compensation), from and against all claims, liabilities, damages, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees), that arise in any way from Student's participation in the field trip and that are incurred by the indemnified parties, whether by way of judgment, settlement or compromise, including any claim based upon or action brought for (i) the negligence or wrongdoing of Student or (ii) the concurrent negligence or wrongdoing of Student and of any person, including any indemnified party.

If there is a medical emergency during this field trip and the Undersigned cannot promptly be located at the telephone numbers appearing below to give such consent, the Undersigned hereby authorize(s) John Crabb, Sheila Marks, Betsy Youngman, David Rowe, Jennifer Sterling Barker, Georgia Buelow, Kathy Malone, Kevin Cherilla and Kelsey Neal to act as the Undersigned's agents during and throughout this field trip to consent to any x-ray examinations, anesthetic, medical, dental or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care to be rendered to Student under the general or special supervision and upon the advice of a licensed physician, dentist, or surgeon.
