

5th Grade Supply List 2021 - 2022

Students should come to school on the first day with the following:

- 1 - Large 3-ring binder, zippered
- 12 - Wooden pencils or 2 mechanical pencils, minimum
- Ballpoint pen(s) (black, red, and blue ink)
- 1 – Sharpie (permanent marker) – ultra fine point
- Notebook paper (standard 8" x 11") college ruled
- 1 – 3-ring pencil holder/pouch/case
- 2 - Highlighter pens
- Large eraser
- Earbuds (not headphones)
- Water bottle with student's name

HOME STUDY AREA:

It is expected that parents provide the student with a specific place to study, preferably at a desk or a table. This area should be quiet and free of distraction, well lit, and well ventilated. It is encouraged that students not take phone calls or watch television while studying. We strongly encourage having Internet access in a common area of the home so that it is possible to monitor its use. We hope that you and your child will explore the best learning style, environment, and time to study.

Scissors
"Post it" notes and "Post it" index tabs
Paper clips

Transparent tape
Glue sticks or rubber cement
Paper reinforcement
